✓ Consumer protection (TD/B/C.I/CPLP/26) and Competition (TD/B/C.I/CLP/61): open to member States on a voluntary basis, without any financial implications for the regular budget of the United Nations, to further discuss and improve the existing procedures and methodology based on the possible improvements identified to date and to report to the twentieth session of the Intergovernmental Group of Experts on Competition Law and Policy
